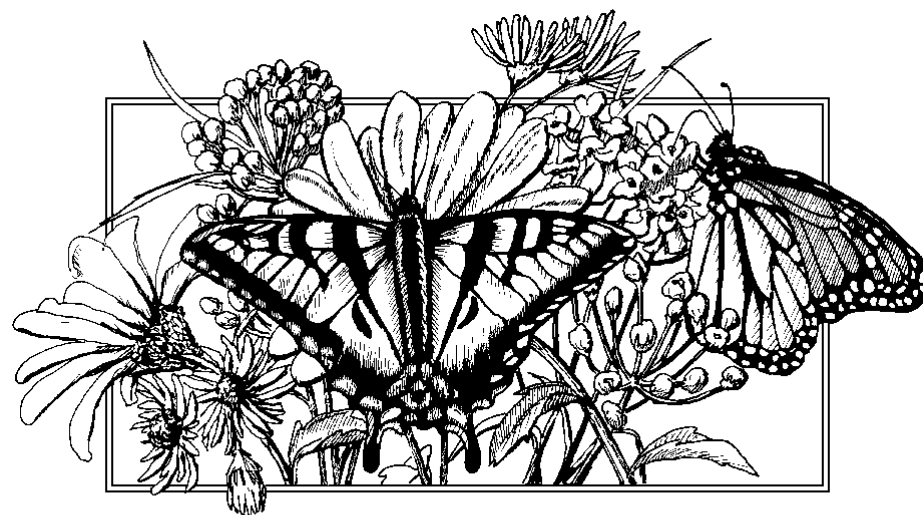

Hope you all are doing well. We are here in Latvia teaching for the week. It is a little dreary here, since their spring begins with a lot of fog, from the melting snow and warmer air.

*We want to share something with you, to see if the Church there in Purcellville would like to be involved. Judy and I are helping to lead a Discipleship school in Sarajevo, Bosnia, from April to June this year. The students will most likely be financially challenged, so we anticipate needing to subsidize their fees a bit, while they seek the Lord for the remainder. Looks like we could use about \$2000 for start up costs etc. **Would you all pray and see if the Lord would have you to be involved in any financial way?** We have never asked anything like this before, but just thought you all might like to have some personal involvement in something like this. Maybe even some individuals would like to involve themselves as a personal project. Well, thanks for letting me run this by you guys.*
