1938 St. Louis Reconciliation: On June 2nd the pastor was sent to represent the ministries of Virginia (through the representation of Intercessors For America) in a historical gathering of all the survivors of the 1938 ship St. Louis that traveled from Europe to the United States filled with thousands of Jews fleeing Nazi Germany. It was turned away and sent back to Europe. This resulted in the majority of those on board being sent to the Nazi concentration camps. This rejection fostered a subliminal message to the Nazi regime which added incentive to Hitler's *Final Solution* scheme with the programmed murder of 6 million Jews and other minority groups. Current living survivors of the St. Louis (50 of the children on board that ship) will hear statements of apology and regret in recognizing this tragic blot on our nation's history. The site of the rejection of the St. Louis was Ft. Lauderdale, FL where the reconciliation will take place. The pastor will be returning on June 7th.
